Weighting method	Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2019”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2019 Edition)”.

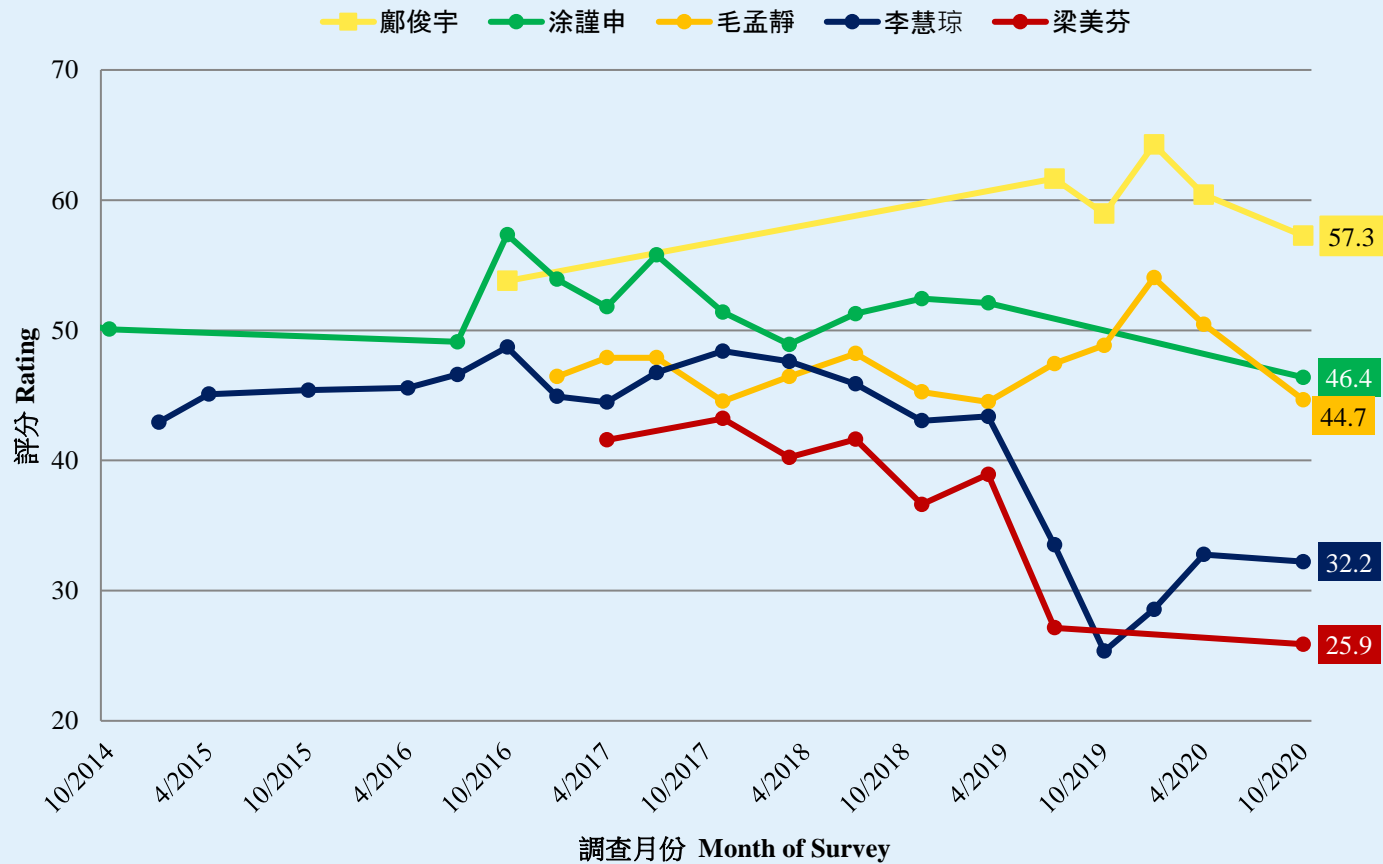
- In this latest survey, top 5 Legislative Councillors are Roy Kwong, James To, Claudia Mo, Starry Lee and Priscilla Leung. Alvin Yeung obtains a rating of 44.8 marks, but is dropped due to his relatively low recognition rate. Meanwhile, the ratings of Priscilla Leung and Alvin Yeung have registered record lows since they were first rated in 2017.

- Compared to six months ago, the ratings of DAB, FTU, BPA and Liberal Party have dropped significantly. The ratings of People Power and Civic Passion register record highs since they were first rated in 2011 and 2016 respectively, while that of LSD also registers **record high** since 2014. On the other hand, the ratings of FTU, Liberal Party, Civic Party and New People's Party register **record lows** since they were first rated in 1991, 1993, 2006 and 2011 respectively.

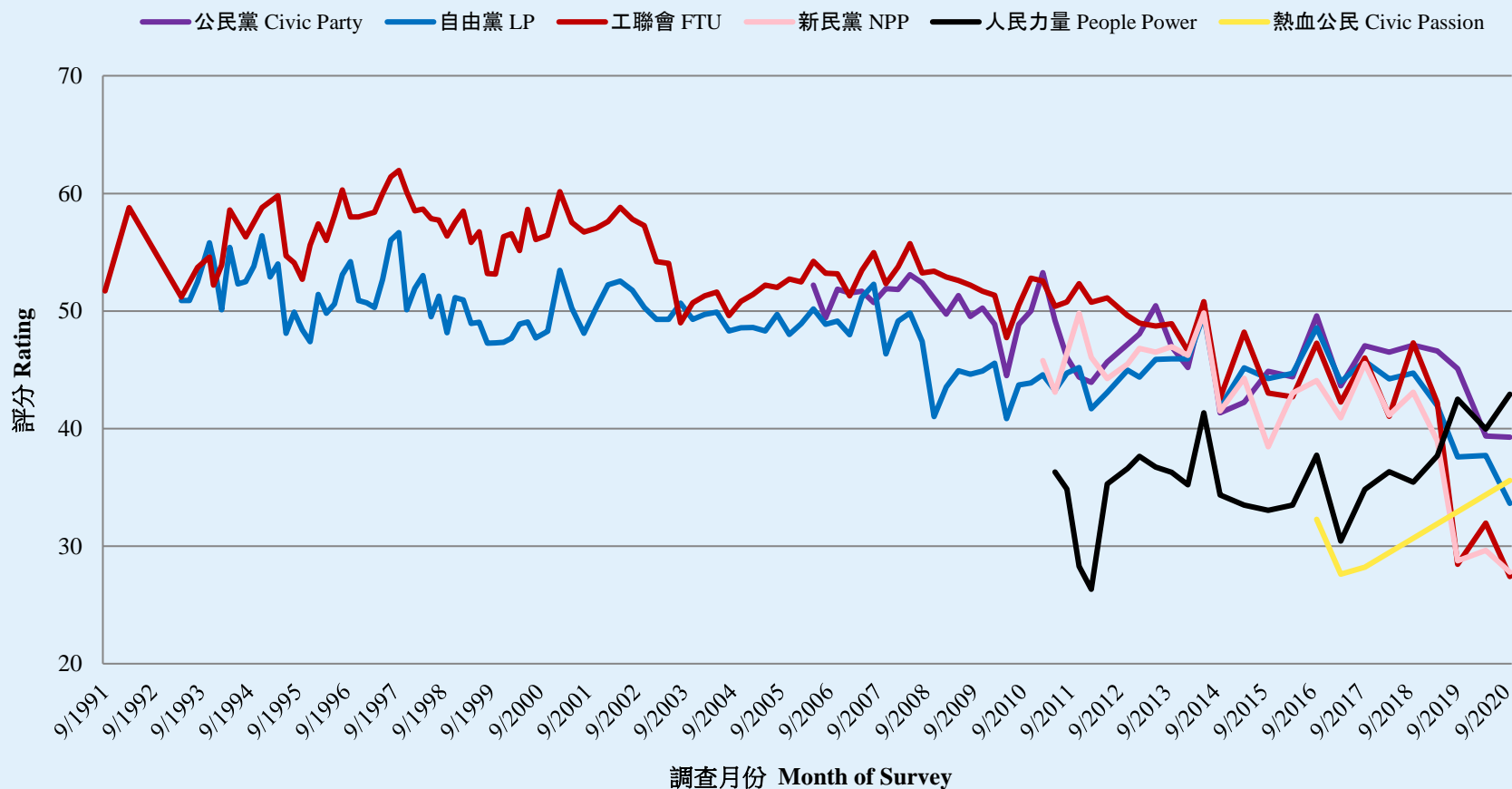
