香港民研公布紀律部隊民望及其他調查結果、 以及「民主社區互助共融」計劃最新發展

香港民意研究所之香港民意研究計劃 (香港民研) 將於明日下午 (12月6日) 舉行發布會，發放「我們香港人 We Hongkongers」、香港民研定期發放之紀律部隊民望，以及「區選覓途 DE Way Out」的最新調查結果。

另外，香港民研於 11 月底區議會選舉結束後隨即開展「民主社區互助共融 CICD」計劃，為香港的文明和民主發展揭開新一頁。計劃的宗旨在於為香港人提供平台，透過互相尊重、理性商討、文明討論、同理思維、社交凝聚和在必要時以民主方法排解糾紛等方法去重新融合。和而不同，多元團結，是我們的理想。計劃會透過各個區議員的領導，連結社區成員進行新時代新概念的社區建設。宏觀發展方面，則交由各區議會主席負責帶領。截至 12 月 4 日，計劃已收到約 20 位候任區議員報名參加。

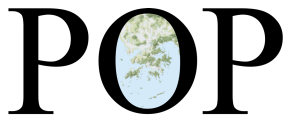

HKPOP releases the popularity of disciplinary forces and other survey results, as well as the latest development of the CICD Project

Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference **tomorrow afternoon (December 6)**, where HKPOP will announce the latest results of “We Hongkongers 我們香港人”, HKPOP’s tracking survey on the popularity of disciplinary forces and “DE Way Out 區選覓途”.

Meanwhile, upon completion of the District Council Election in late November, HKPOP has immediately launched the “Community Integration through Civility and Democracy (CICD) 民主社區互助共融” Project in order to bring Hong Kong to new heights in terms of civility and democracy. The purpose of the CICD Project is to provide a means for Hongkongers to re-integrate ourselves through mutual respect, rational deliberations, civilized discussions, personal empathy, social integration, and when needed, resolution of conflicts through democratic means. Unity in diversity is our ideal. CICD would engage Hongkongers across all communities in a modern and brand-new way via the leadership of individual District Councillors within their own service districts and the Chairmen of District Councils where overall macroscopic development is concerned. As of December 4, the Project has received about 20 applications from District Councillor designates for participation.

In the first two parts of press conference, latest results of “We Hongkongers”, popularity of disciplinary forces, and “DE Way Out” will be released. In the third part, Robert Chung, President and CEO of HKPORI will announce latest development of the “CICD” project, details as follows:
