- Date of survey: 2-5/2/2021
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18+
- Sample size: 1,018 (including 514 landline and 504 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 62.9%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4%, that of net values not more than +/-7% and that of ratings not more than +/-2.6 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2019”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2019 Edition)”.

- Our latest survey shows that the popularity rating of CE Carrie Lam now stands at 31.0 marks, 42% of the sample gave her 0 mark. Her approval rate is 18%, disapproval rate 70%, giving a net popularity of negative 52 percentage points. All popularity figures have not changed much from half a month ago.

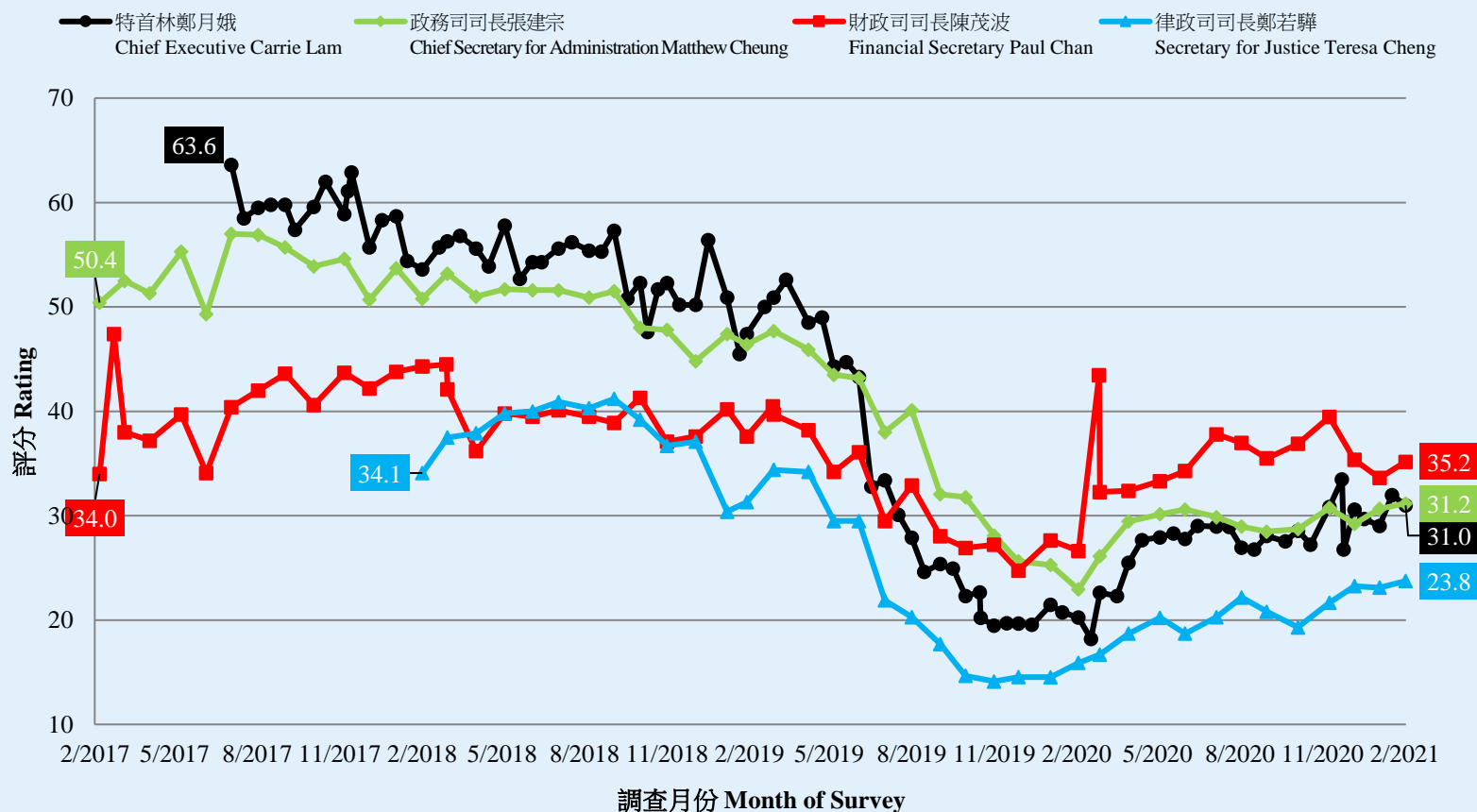

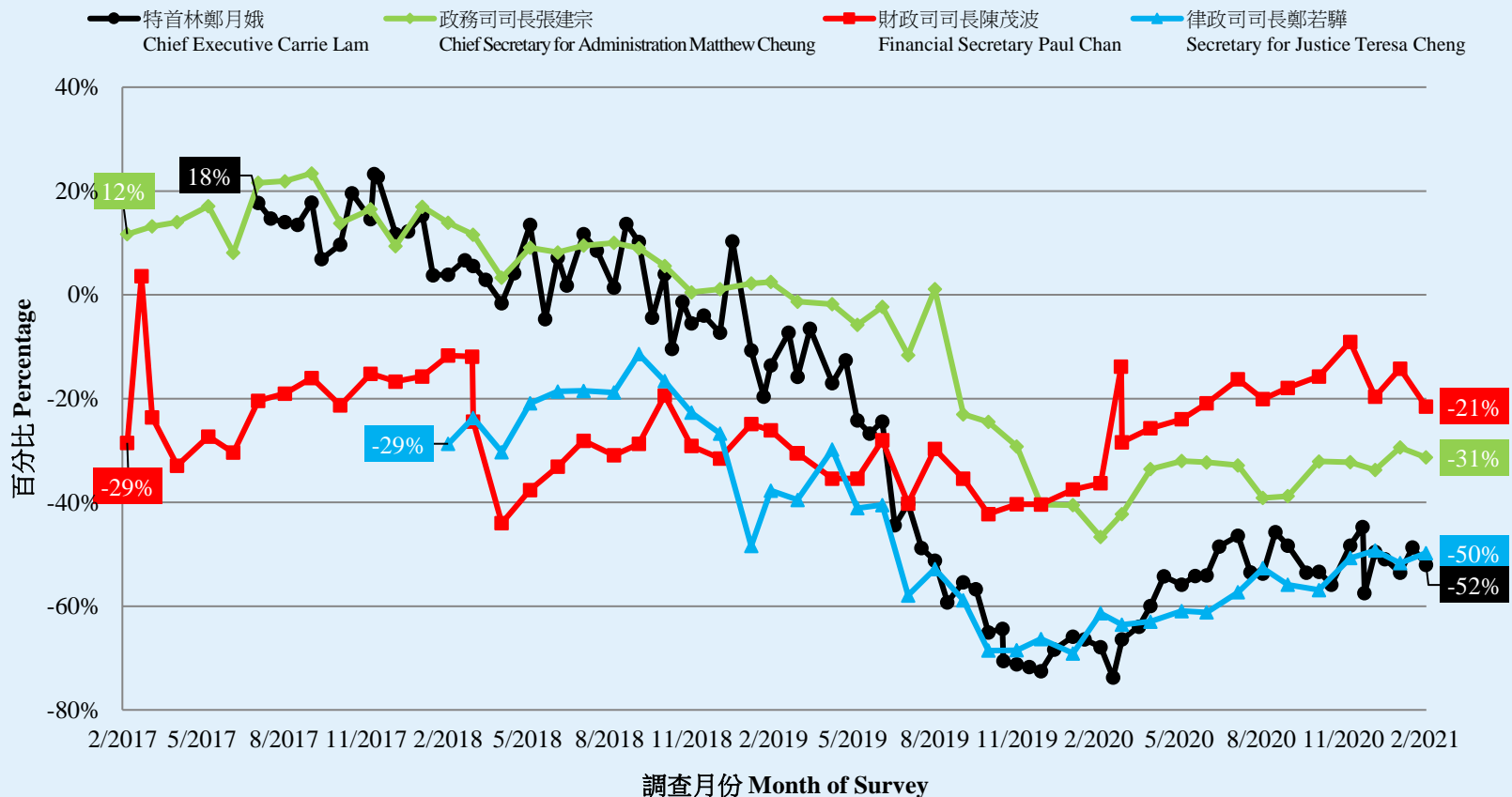
