HKPOP will release next Wednesday ratings of Legislative Councillors, Budget follow-up survey and latest results of “Community Health Survey”

Due to Easter public holidays, the Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will change its regular press conference from next Tuesday to **next Wednesday (April 15)** afternoon. The ratings of Legislative Councillors and results of our budget follow-up survey will be released. Both are the last of their series before July 1, 2020. Whether the surveys will be continued depends on the amount of public support. The media is invited to send representatives to attend the press conference and to sponsor the above-mentioned survey at \$8,000 per question in order to receive the results in advance.

Moreover, the “Community Health Project” launched by HKPOP recently asks people whether they support the government’s latest measures of prohibiting gatherings of more than four people, their appraisal of the performance by law enforcement agencies and expectations on how the pandemic develops for people to go back to work as normal. It also continues to track people’s self-assessment of getting infected, their mask reserves, and so on via the website <http://bit.ly/poricdche>. Latest results will be released at the press conference, details to be confirmed.
