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- Date of survey: 4-7/7/2022
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,003 (including 501 landline and 502 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 50.1%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-3%, that of net values not more than +/-6% and that of ratings not more than +/-0.1 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2021”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2021 Edition)”.

Survey Result - Trust and Confidence Indicators

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● People's trust in the HKSAR Government

Trust	40%	47%	▲7% *	Record high since Sept. 2018
Distrust	35%	31%	▼4%	Record low since Nov. 2017
Net trust	5%	16%	▲11% *	Record high since Jun. 2018
Mean value	3.0	3.2	▲0.2 *	Record high since Nov. 2017

- Regarding people's trust in the HKSAR Government, 47% of the respondents expressed trust, 31% expressed distrust, thus the net trust value is positive 16 percentage points. The mean score is 3.2, meaning between “half-half” and “quite trust” in general.

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● People's trust in the Beijing Central and Taiwan Governments

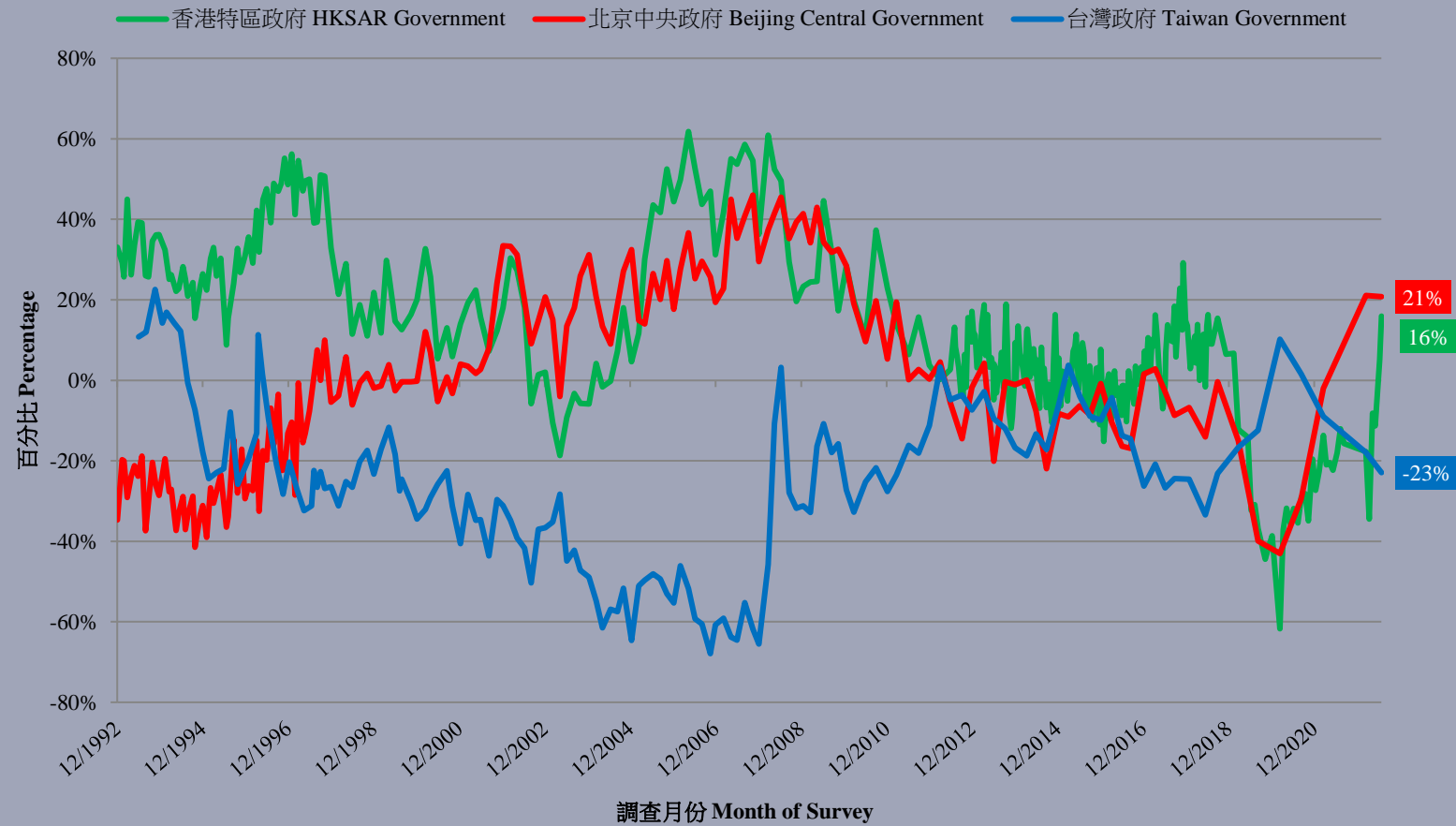

Net trust in Beijing Government	21%	21%	--	Record low since Aug. 2021
Net trust in Taiwan Government	-18%	-23%	▼5%	Record low since Sept. 2018

- The net trust values in the Beijing Central Government and the Taiwan Government are positive 21 and negative 23 percentage points respectively. Compared to 5 months ago, both figures have not changed much.

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- **People’s confidence in the future and in “one country, two systems”**

Net confidence in HK’s future	-8%	21%	▲29% *	Record high since Mar. 2013
Net confidence in China’s future	41%	43%	▲1%	Record high since Jan. 2018
Net confidence in “one country, two systems”	-1%	20%	▲21% *	Record high since Mar. 2013

- Net confidence in the future of China stands at positive 43 percentage points, registering a new record **high** since January 2018, while net confidence in the future of Hong Kong and in “one country, two systems” stands at positive 21 and positive 20 percentage points respectively, which have **increased significantly** by 29% and 21% respectively compared to 5 months ago, both registering a new record **high** since March 2013.
